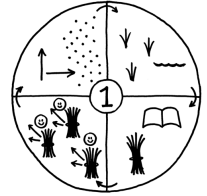




Five Skills in John 4

For One Field One Goal



The Five skills are not a formula.

It's NOT about getting the sequence right, although it is helpful.

Rather it's about making sure relationship is right. God works through relationship.

1. Get Connected.



2. My Story.



3. Gospel.



4. Lead People to Believe and Baptise Them.



5. Disciple in Groups.



John 4:1-42. What did Jesus do?

- Jesus gets connected. He talks about everyday things (4:7-9)
- He asks questions to find if she is open to spiritual things (4:10-15)
- Jesus gets to the real issue: her sin. She is lost. (4:16-19)
- He then gets to the Gospel: He is the solution. (4:25-26)
- The woman believes, then shares her story with others. (4:39-42)
- Jesus stays two days more at Samaria. Discipling. (4:40-42)

The John 4 story line applied today.

- Connect relationally and get to spiritual talk in your time and way.
- Talk about, get to, the real problem - sin. **(Problem)**
- Go the Gospel - Jesus. **(Solution)**
- Ask questions like: "Do you believe this?" **(Response)**
- If they are interested, or believe, encourage them to share with others.
- Follow up for discipleship.
