


Form Churches with 3 Parts Pattern



Model and Demonstrate

Model the 3 Parts Pattern & model the Indicators of a church.

- Show new followers by your actions and way of life the indicators of what is a church.
- Do this until they understand and are a multiplying Churches/ Gatherings.
- Find Persons of Peace and train them.
- Train leaders. Give them vision and things to do.

Why use a Pattern with the 3 parts?

- 1. Ordinary people can copy it and do it!
- 2. For discipleship in groups
- 3. To form a healthy Church/ Gathering
- 4. Can be used also for one-on-one discipleship
- 5. To care for one another and celebration
- 6. To check for obedience and application
- 7. To send people to multiply groups and churches
- 8. To train and mentor leaders

Where early believers commonly met together.

- Acts 5:42, 12:12, 20:8, 20:20

Grow groups to become multiplying Churches.

a) Transition from Group to Church.



- Move quickly from learning about Jesus and the Bible to become a community that loves and cares for each other and the lost.
- A discipleship group **needs to know when** they become a Church/ Gathering.
- b) Use Scripture to Show "You are a Church/ Gathering".



- Confirm them as a church when they practice the indicators from Acts and are following Jesus commands.
- This is not a formula, but how life is lived together in Christ.

Acts 14:21-23. Groups are called a Church before elders are appointed.

Multiply many Leaders and Churches.

Use "One Field One Goal" to equip leaders.

- Train leaders to pray and think BIG about multiplying to other areas.
- Use maps. Use data. Make plans together.



c) Acts 20:17-20. Paul demonstrated first, so new leaders could follow his example.

ACTIVITY Discuss together what you need to model to emerging leaders so they can multiply into a movement.

- d) People follow what you MODEL to them.
 - Show people how to lead before appointing leaders and elders.
 - Always model love, always have a co-leader. Practice 2 Tim 2:2
 - Train and mentor constantly.
