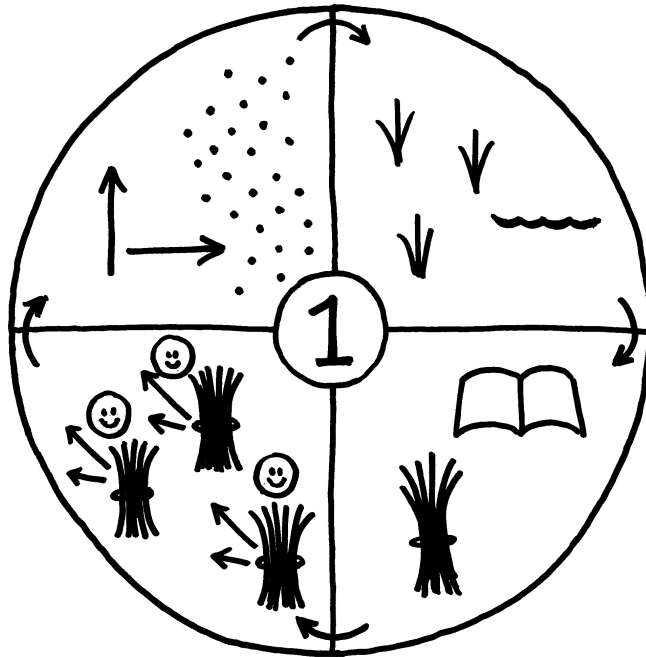








One Field One Goal strategy and Four Transitions

Four key transitions to watch out for.

The line represents **obstacles and barriers**, or where there are **opportunities**.

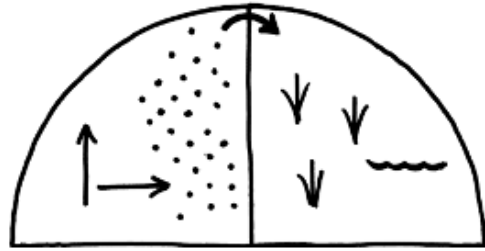
- Where things can get **stuck or stop**. A **lack of clear vision** to keep focused.
- Things you or others may experience such as **fears or lack of skills** and confidence.
- **Cultural and social issues** to do with the people you are reaching, or with yourself.
- Situations where we need to "get over the line" and keep moving forward.

The curved arrow - keep moving forward, don't get stuck!

Transition 1

Transition from **seed sowing** to leading people **to believe and baptise them**.

Transition 2

What do you do with a new Believer?

Establish new followers in long term Discipleship and Gathering together, and reaching others.

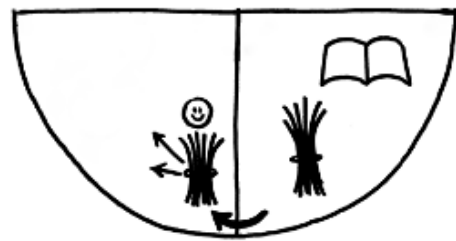
Get over the line.
