# 21 Discipleship Studies

Discipling Disciple-Makers

**Use the "Three Thirds Pattern" to gather people.** People need to see that it is easy to lead a Gathering and copy it. Some people may already be baptised, some not yet. Some may not yet even have believed upon Jesus, therefore often give opportunity for people **to make a decision to believe** and follow Christ and to be baptised.

Emphasize regularly the importance of starting new Gatherings and passing on what they are learning in each study passage – discipling people to become Disciple-Makers.

# Use questions to help understand, apply and obey scripture. Note for facilitators/leaders.

- Leaders you should not be doing all the talking.
- Trust the Holy Spirit to work in people's hearts.
- Ask the questions and then let participants talk and interact.
- Then, if you think they missed something, you can add to what they said.
  - 1. What is the passage about and what do we learn from this passage?
  - 2. How should we apply and obey this in our life?
  - 3. Who can I tell this to?
