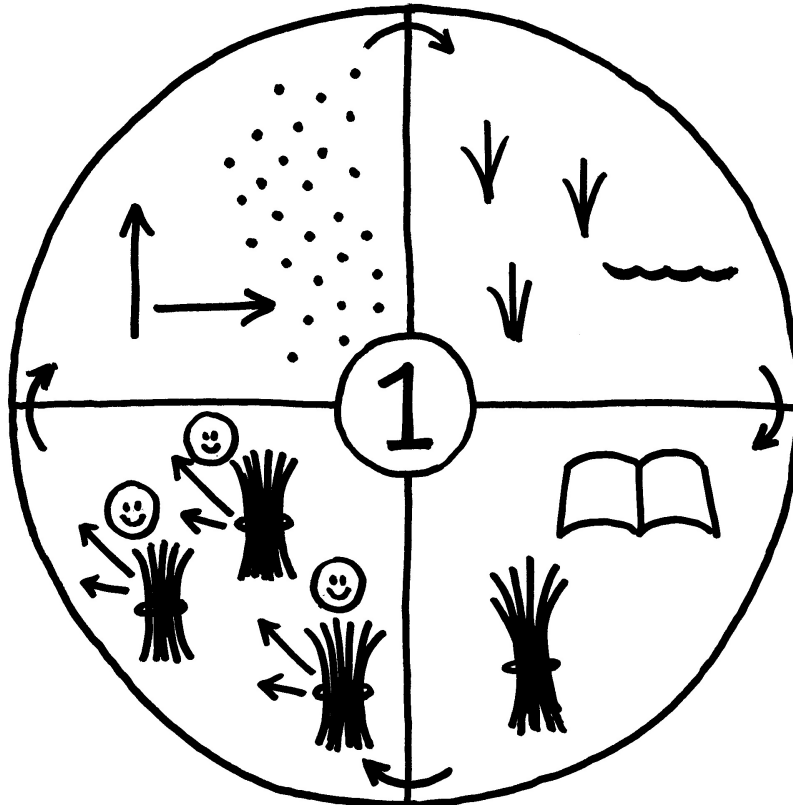

Matthew **13:38** "The field is the world..." He is at work in your context.







There is One Goal.

These six are the activities for One Field One Goal approach.



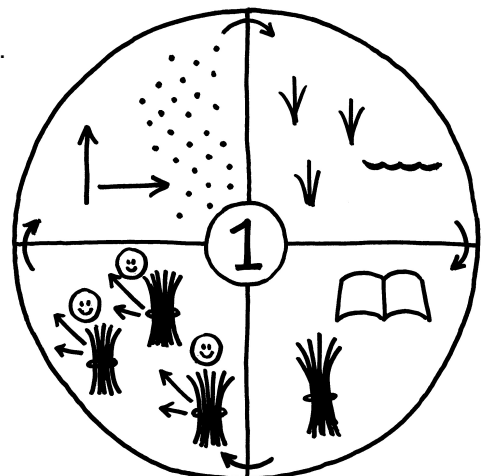

There are four transitions to watch out for.

Situations where we need to "get over the line".
Where things can get stuck or stop, a barrier, or where there is an opportunity.

B. Learn to draw the ONE FIELD ONE GOAL approach.

1. Draw a big circle.
2. Draw a small circle in the middle of the big circle. That's the Vision.
3. Draw the two vertical lines and two horizontal lines.
4. Write a 1 in the middle.
5. Draw the "Pray and Go" arrows first. 
6. Continue drawing clockwise.
7. Draw it from memory and share it with someone else.



1-6-4 in more depth.

1 One Goal - Start Kingdom Movements Everywhere

① This is your Kingdom focus, your vision. Keep it central in your life.

Jesus' Vision - The Kingdom of God. Make it your own.

- We need to start with the correct vision – see the BIG picture of what God wants to do.
- Matt. 4:17, 4:23, Matt. 6:10, Luke 8:1, Matt. 24:14-15, Mark 1:14-15, Luke 12:31-32.

Jesus' Strategy - Disciple Making. Make it your own.

- Matt 28:18-20. Jesus commissions his people to start movements of disciple making.
- The strategy is making disciples, who can make more disciples and form communities of believers.

Holy Spirit and Harvest

- **Acts 2:1-6 Acts 2:40-41.** Holy Spirit came on the Day of Pentecost, as they celebrated the harvest. Ex 12:12-13.
- On that day a worldwide spiritual **HARVEST** and **GATHERING** started.
- You are part of this today. We bring a harvest to the Lord.
- Methods and patterns are helpful. **Being empowered Holy Spirit is essential.**
- Can you “see” the harvest today in your focus location? John 4:35

The Problem of Lostness.

Gen. 3:1-15; 3:20-24, Matt 1:20-21, 15:19-20, Luke 15:1-10, 19: 8-10, Acts 26: 17-18.

- Jesus came to solve the spiritual problem of lostness, separated from God and his presence.
- The real issue is that people are separated from the source of life and their original identity. They are God's creation suffering under the sin problem.
- Therefore, do not be fearful or intimidated by people's religion, philosophy, status or culture – “labels”. These are not the main problem to overcome.
- Stop Seeing People with “Labels” - See them as Lost.

Key Apostolic Activities Start Disciple Making Movements.

- These apostolic activities establish people as disciples of Jesus.
- These activities establish movements of Churches / Gatherings.

Acts 11:19-26, Acts 14:1-7 + 14:21-23 One story in two parts - all six activities happening.

1. Pray and Go

- Where will you go? Be specific. Think, pray, and plan really BIG.
- See the Lost. Know your data.
- The harvest is ripe. The Kingdom is here.



2. Spread Good News

- Share your testimony. Share the Good News of salvation.
- Heal the sick, cast out demons.
- Demonstrate with good works that the Kingdom has come.



3. Believe and Baptise

- Lead people to believe and baptise them. Local people begin to lead others to Christ and baptise them.



4. Disciple

- Train new believers to share with others, gather others, and make other disciples. Discipling in groups is the beginning of forming



a Church / Gathering.

5. Gather

- Gathering and Discipling work together. One serves the other.
- Networks of Churches/ Gatherings are formed. This multiplies leaders.

6. Multiply Leaders and Churches

- Give responsibility. Choose fruitful and teachable people according to the 2 Tim 2:2 principle.
- Encourage community engagement in all spheres of life.

➤ The **Apostles learned** the six apostolic activities **from Jesus**.




Four Transitions in the One Field One Goal approach.

There are **4 key transitions** to watch out for.



- **The line** represents obstacles and barriers, or where there are opportunities.
 - Where things can get stuck or stop. A lack of clear vision to keep focused.
 - Things you or others may experience such as fears and lack of skills and confidence.
 - Or cultural and social issues that are to do with the people you are reaching.
 - Situations where we need to “get over the line” and keep moving forward.
- **The arrow** means keep moving forward !

<p>Transition 1 Transition from seed sowing to leading people to believe and baptise them. Get over the line. John 11:26</p> 	
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

<p>Transition 3 Move from initial gathering over to become church. Get over the line.</p> 	
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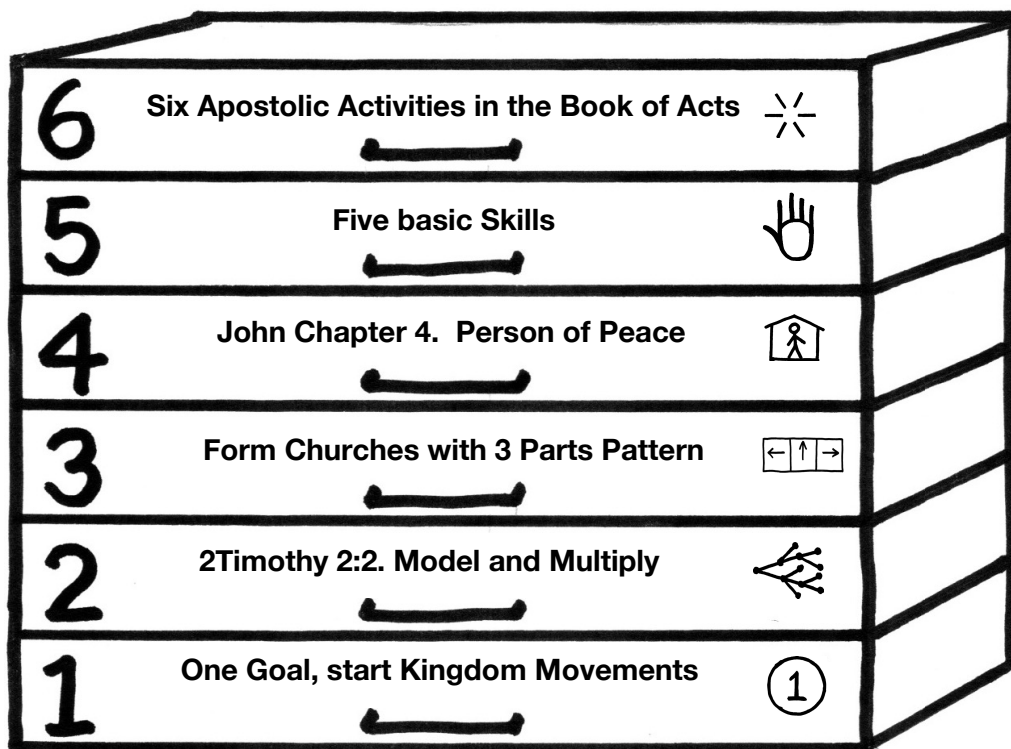

The 654-321 Tool Box

- The 654-321 Tool Box is a set of Biblical Principles, Skills and Processes to help you implement the **One Field One Goal** approach.
- The 654-321 tools help you cooperate with the Lord and others in launching movements of new believers.





Five basic Skills

What did Jesus do? John 4:1-42.

- Jesus gets **connected**. He talks about everyday things (4:7-9)
- He asks **questions** to find if she is open to spiritual things (4:10-15)
- Jesus gets to the real issue: her sin is the **problem**. She is lost. (4:16-19)
- He then gets to the Gospel: He is the **solution**. (4:25-26)
- The woman **believes**, she then shares **her story with others**. (4:39-42)
- Jesus **stays two days** more at Samaria. Discipling. (4:40-42)

Five skills

1. Get Connected

2. My Story. Testimony

3. Gospel

4. Lead People to Believe and Baptise Them

5. Disciple in Groups

- The five skills are not a formula. It's NOT about getting the sequence right. Rather it's about making sure relationship is right. People are not a target.
- You need skills to help you work with the Lord to reach and disciple people He has prepared.

Skill 1. Get Connected. John 4:7-9

Connect Relationally. People are Not a Target.

Say "hello". Talk about spiritual things (John 4:10-15).

Talk to anyone, don't choose. You do not know who will be open.

- Pray for open doors. Col. 4:2-4.
- Demonstrate that the Kingdom has come. Heal the sick, cast out demons.
- This will help you know if they are open.

List now **where** and **who** you will visit and share with.

Skill 2. My Story. John 4:39 The woman's testimony/story.

Give Testimony of What the Lord has Done in Your Life.

1Peter 3:15 Do this with 3 clear parts.

Your story needs to be **true – don't add to it**. Be sensitive to the culture.

- **BEFORE** - Before you came to know Jesus, OR before He did something important in your life after salvation.
- **WHEN** – When did this happened. What were the circumstances?
- **NOW** – Describe how has your life changed and what is different now?

Take time now to prepare your story. Practice now with someone else.

Try to share your story in **under 3 minutes**

Use Questions: What do you believe about my story?

Or, Can I tell you more? Acts 26:27-28. Paul uses a question to stir faith.

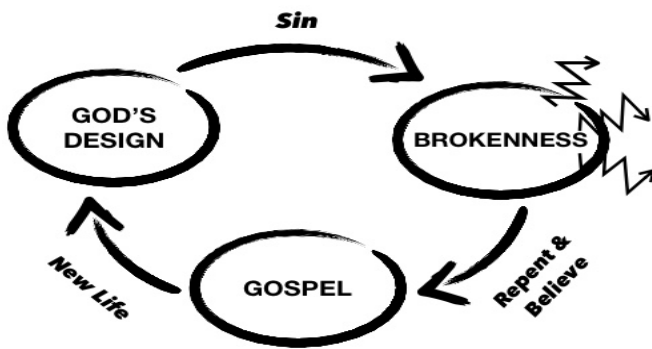
Skill 3. Gospel. John 4:16-19 Problem. John 4:25-26 Solution.

Look for the: Problem, Solution, Response, Result in these passages.

John 4:16-19, Matt 15:10-20, Mark 1:14-15, Acts 2:36-41, Acts 5:30-32, Acts 17:22-34, Rms. 3:23-24, Rms. 10:9-13

Problem Sin & Brokenness.
Solution Jesus. He is the Good News.
Response Believe/Repentance.
 Believing with trust in Jesus' death for sin. Repentance from sin: "I have been wrong before God. I need new life".
 This is not about belonging to a religion, but faith in Christ alone.
Result Forgiveness from God.
 An assurance you are forgiven. New life now: "Christ in you". Col. 1:27. Eternal life.
 The gift of Holy Spirit.

The Three Circles



Share with Anyone.

Do Not Choose Who.

You do not know might be open.



Ask Questions like:

- Which one of these circles do you identify with? Which one would you like to be in?
- How will you know when your sins will be paid for? This is not about religion, but faith.
- Do you believe Jesus came to forgive your sin problem and restore you to his perfect design?

Skill 4. 📖 Lead people to Believe and Baptise them. John 4:39-42

Jesus' example: Believe: John 16:30-31, 11:25-26. Baptise: John 3:22-23.

Apostles' example: Acts 2:38-41, 8:12-13, 16:30-33, 18:8, 19:18-20

📖 **Lead People to Believe.** This is sometimes a process over time, not a single event.

A simple prayer:

"Lord God, I believe Jesus died on the cross for my sins as a perfect sacrifice and was raised. I need forgiveness of my sins and eternal life. I turn from sin and open my life for you to be my Saviour and Lord".

📖 **Baptise Them**

Baptism is a command. It is also a symbol done in faith of identifying with what Jesus has done for us. Who can baptise and where? What does the scripture say?

John 3:22-23, 4:1-2. Jesus himself was not baptising, his disciples were.

1 Cor. 1:14-16. Paul says that he did not baptise anyone except a few people. See Acts 18:8.

Baptism is not about a theology class, but a simple act of identifying with what Christ has done. Baptism does not have to mean a change of culture or community.

Skill 5. 📖 Disciple in Groups John 4:40-42 Jesus' follow-up discipleship.

Jesus constantly gathered and discipled people in small and large groups. Luke 11:1-2.

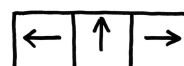
Paul and Barnabas: Acts 11:23+26; 14:21-22

People follow what you **MODEL** to them - more than what you say.

New believers need to **SEE and FEEL** what new life in Christ is like.

Use a 3 Parts Meeting Pattern

1. **Look Back:** What has happened. Testimony. Give thanks.
2. **Look Up:** Learn to apply the Bible **with Questions.**
 (If one hour, then about 20 minutes for each part)



3. Look Forward: Send people with prayer and obedience.

Divide a meeting time roughly into 3 thirds.

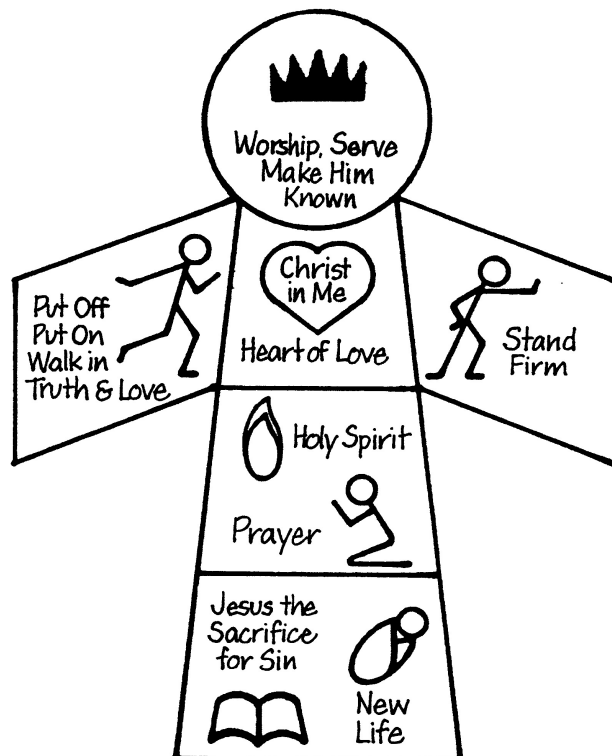
This pattern is a simple way to disciple in groups, or one on one.








Train new followers to do the same thing with others, that you do with them.

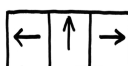

John 4. Look for the Person of Peace

A Person of Peace “opens doors” for the Gospel into social networks.

- Look for key people (person of peace) who can gather others.
- We find them by sharing the Gospel, loving people, and by demonstrating Kingdom power.
- Luke 8:38-40, Luke 10:1-12, John 4:28-30, 4:39-42, Acts 10:1-4 + 24-33



Form Churches with 3 Parts Pattern

Discipling in a group is the **BEGINNING** of forming a Church/ Gathering.

The 3 Parts Meeting Pattern. (The same pattern in “Disciple in Groups”. Skill 5)

The 3 parts pattern helps new followers grow in obedience, love and most important, it helps them form more discipleship groups and churches. It is simple to follow.

1. **Look Back:** What has happened. Testimony. Give thanks.
2. **Look Up:** Learn to apply the Bible **with Questions.**
(If one hour, then about 20 minutes for each part)
3. **Look Forward:** Send people with prayer and obedience.

Indicators of a Church/ Gathering.

- Acts 2:36-47 shows us the basic ACTIVITIES & FUNCTIONS of a new community of believers.
- Acts 2:36-47 is not a formula, but rather a description of life together that comes from following Jesus and being filled with his Holy Spirit.
- Send New Followers to start New Groups.



2 Timothy 2:2. Model and Multiply.

Multiplication by training and modelling to capable people.

Apostle Paul's secret key to multiplication.

- Paul disciplined Timothy,
- Timothy taught & disciplined "reliable/capable people",
- They were able to train and disciple many "others".
Acts 19:9-10. What do you think Paul did for two years?
